THE FINE PRINT

ADVANCE TICKET SALES: Passes and tickets can be purchased online up to one (1) hour before showtime, by ticket hotline, or in person at SIFF Uptown's box office during their regular hours. A processing fee of \$1.25 per event is charged for online and phone purchases, with a maximum of \$5 per order; there are no fees for walkups.

Advance purchases can be picked up at the SIFF Film Center or at SIFF Uptown before the day-of-show. On day-of-show, advance purchase tickets and passes can be picked up at the venue's will-call, which opens 30 minutes before showtime. Neither passes nor tickets may be picked up at the SJCC.

DAY-OF-SHOW TICKET SALES: On-site ticket sales open 30 minutes prior to showtime (one hour prior on Opening Night). Seating is guaranteed until ten minutes prior to screening. No late seating.

PURCHASES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.

SPONSOR BENEFITS: Sponsor invitations and passes will be mailed in February. When you arrive at a film or event, please have your pass ready for checking/marking to avoid delays.


